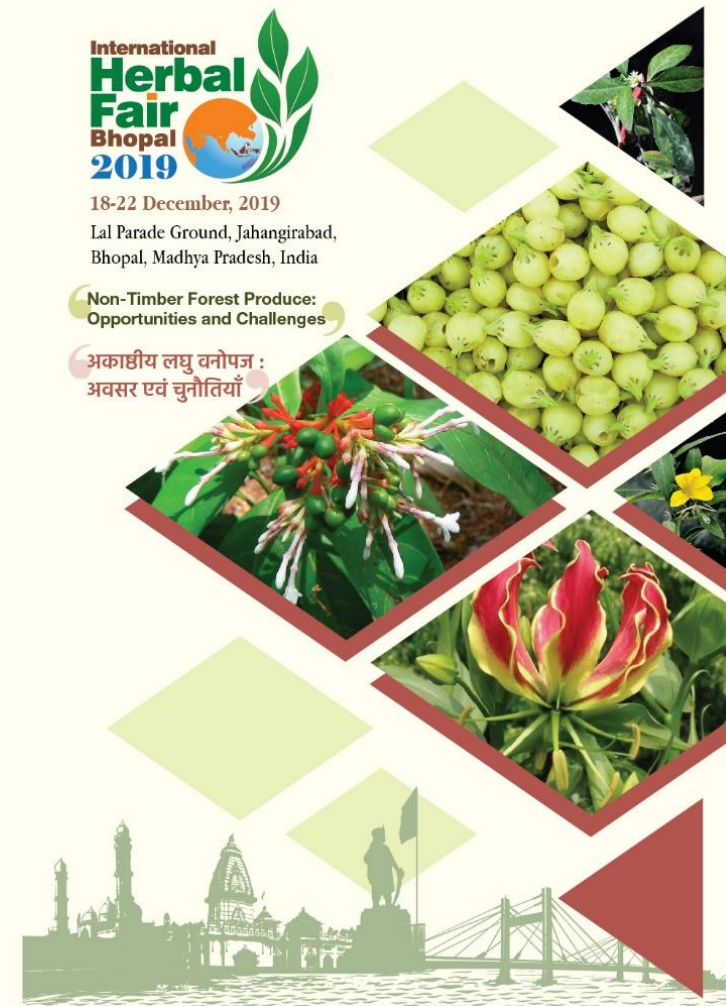

# 7<sup>th</sup> INTERNATIONAL HERBAL FAIR 2019

Herbal/NTFPs Fair is an annual feature of Bhopal for over a decade now. Initially, began as a National event, this annual fair was up-scaled as an International event from 2011 with a mandate to create a platform for showcasing the NTFPs/MAPs diversity/potential of various states of India and neighbouring countries to provide robust marketing opportunities with strong backward-forward linkages for NTFPs collectors, traders and manufacturers.

## Organisers

Co-organized by the Madhya Pradesh Forest Department, GoMP and Madhya Pradesh State Minor Forest Produce (Trade & Development) Co-operative Federation Ltd. The lead organiser, MP MFP Federation is an apex level agency with a membership of over three million MFP collectors largely dependent on forest produce for their livelihood. It is also an active promoter of collection, trade and development of NTFPs including medicinal and aromatic plants in the state.

## Theme of the Herbal Fair

### Non-Timber Forest Produce: Opportunities and Challenges

- Non-timber forest products (NTFPs) are of socio-economic and cultural importance for the forest dwelling communities, particularly for the tropical countries like India.
- NTFPs have attracted considerable global attention due to their significant role in benefiting people and industries. There has been a growing demand worldwide for NTFPs as people increasingly seek "natural products" in domestic and international markets.
- The competition and demand for the forest products or NTFPs promotes over exploitation, destructive harvesting practices, and pre-mature harvesting.
